THREE WAY PARENT / TEACHER / STUDENT INTERVIEWS – August 1st and 2nd

Our three way Parent/Teacher/Student interviews will be held on 1st and 2nd August in week 2 of term 3. This year we are using an online tool for you to book your appointment times with teachers. Details of how to book were emailed yesterday. This year you can also book to talk to our specialist teachers for Japanese, PEARLS, Performing Arts and PE. Bookings must be finalised before 31st July at 4pm, when bookings for this event will close.

If you have more than one child at school please book early to make sure you can get appointment times close together but leave a gap between each of your bookings (do not make them back to back) to enable you to have sufficient time to move between locations.

For families that do not have internet access, a laptop kiosk will be available at the front office from today Monday 26th June until 31st July, for parents to make their own bookings. Alternatively parents may send a note to school with the approximate times they require, or phone the school on 8353 2444. Students with written permission from parents may also have supervised access to the kiosk. Interviews are strictly 15 mins long. If you require more time, please contact your teacher directly to make alternative arrangements.

One of our major focus areas of these interviews concentrates on assisting students to take more responsibility for their learning. The interview process allows students to reflect on their learning, take responsibility for and celebrate success, plan for the future and share what they are feeling about themselves as learners. Leading up to the interviews we will be coaching students through an interview process and asking them to reflect upon their learning and work habits. This process is a great way for students to learn the skills of communicating effectively and demonstrate what they know and how they can improve for their future.

It is vital for the students of today to learn the skills of communicating effectively, to demonstrate what they know and reflect upon strategies for improvement. We encourage parents to raise any concerns about your child with the class teacher at any time. You do not have to wait until interviews.
